## Seasonal employment guidelines

The Niagara Frontier Transportation Authority is looking to provide temporary employment for individuals 18 years of age and up. The program would allow the NFTA to supplement its cleaning efforts of the bus fleet. A team of five (5) washers per garage totaling 15 would allow for each bus/para transit van to be cleaned thoroughly as well as the Operator's areas detailed, thus improving the ride for the public and Operator.

Duties:                                        Employee will become part of our GREEN TEAM, where he/she will assist with the NFTA's "Keeping It Clean, Clean is Green" Program and help clean the buses and vans that our customers use every day. Employee will be assigned as needed to cleaning and preparing vehicles for service, including out-of-service vehicles in or about the property. Tasks involve the intermittent performance of physically demanding work, typically involving some combination of bending, squatting reaching, kneeling, climbing (stairs), twisting (hand/arm) and/or rotating (hand/arm). May involve the lifting (20-80+ pounds), carrying (10-50 pounds), pushing and/or pulling (mop/broom) of materials. Job involves standing for up to one hour at a time for two hours per day, sitting for one hour at a time for hours per day and walking three hours at a time for four hours per day. Employee will be required to wear appropriate clothing for work including shirts given by the NFTA.

Qualifications:                            Must be 18 years of age. Applicants will be required to take a pre-employment physical and drug screen test.

Duties:                                 NFTA's is once again running "Pathway to the NFTA Mechanical Program" allows for individuals with a mechanical background or training to use that training on the buses and vans that our customers use every day. Employee will be assigned as needed. Position may require some lifting of supplies and equipment. Particular work would include, but not limited to: Incomplete work in scheduled maintenance, Emission maintenance; Overhead adjustments; Fuel injectors; Campaigns; Air Compressor and Air Dryer maintenance; and Cell Mobile Router installs. Employee will be required to wear appropriate clothing for work including shirts given by the NFTA.

Qualifications:                      Must be 18 years of age. Employee will be required to take a Mechanical Skills test as well as a pre-employment physical, drug screen test and go through the interview process.
